

HOME CARE

A service provided by a caregiver, in your home, to assist with safety, health and independence.

Home Care services include:

Home Care can be provided up to 24 hours a day, wherever you call "Home".

A professionally trained caregiver can assist in improved nutrition and hydration, medication compliance and fewer trips to the Emergency Room due to falls, infection and illness.

Washington State Home Care Agencies are licensed with the Department of Health and are bonded. They provide additional security such as background checks, required fingerprinting and conduct formal training to their caregiving team.

Usually ordered by a physician at the time of discharge from a hospital or skilled nursing community.

- Teaching & Training
- Ostomy & Colostomy Care

- Home Health Aid to Assist with Bathing

Home Health can build strength, prevent falls, and help avoid repeated trips to the Emergency Room.

Patients, Families or Nurses may request Home Health services from the physician when the patient has had a change in level of function or experienced an exacerbation of their diagnosis.
